

# Building our Eclipse Indigo Environment from the Eclipse Web Site

- 1) Go to <http://www.eclipse.org/downloads/>
- 2) Download and unzip/tar -xvf [Eclipse IDE for C/C++ Developers](#), Be sure to select the correct version (Windows32/Windows64/ Linux32/Linux64) for your host system. This is the official version. See the [Install Guide](#) on this page for more information.
- 3) Start up Eclipse Indigo
- 4) Select the Help -> Install New Software menu selection
- 5) In the Dialog that appears set: **work with:** -Indigo-....
- 6) In the list that appears click Programming Languages and check the "Eclipse Java Development" checkbox
- 7) Click the NEXT button at the bottom of the page, and NEXT/FINISH buttons in the following windows to install the Eclipse Java Development plug-in into your version of Eclipse
- 8) Restart Eclipse at the end of the install. You will now have exactly what is in our .zip/ tar.gz
